I wrote to the Chief Constable of North Wales on 6 March 2004 to request information pertaining to statements made by himself and Chief Inspector Richard Hughes about pubic support for the use of speed cameras. In response, Beth Sian Mitcheson, communications manager with the North Wales Arrive Alive scheme, has provided us with the following documents:
