

Drivers who use their mobiles at the wheel could face jail.

Those **targeted** under the **crackdown** could include motorists who cause fatalities while using their mobile phones. Drivers who use a handheld mobile phone at the wheel could soon face jail. Currently regarded as a minor offence, it is among several to be reclassified as serious under tough legal reforms. These include running a red light, "undertaking" on the inside, tailgating, applying make-up or even tuning the radio while driving.

In a **shake-up** proposed by **the Director of Public Prosecutions, Ken Macdonald**, they could meet the more serious charge of dangerous driving.
