Motorcycle training courses available for the public

In an effort to reduce the number of motorcycle casualties, the North Wales Police Driving School is offering motorcycle courses to members of the public. The training will be provided by police advanced motorcycle instructors, who are also registered with the Driving Standards Agency to provide post test motorcycle training.

Courses will be designed to meet the needs of individual students and will be based on ‘**Motorcycle Roadcraft**’ and the **Highway Code**. Those that successfully complete the course will qualify for a possible discount of between 15 to 17% from major insurance companies.

The course is available to those who have passed their test and wish to develop their riding skills further. One and two day courses or a week’s course are being offered and are available on the following dates:

17th to 20th March

2nd to 4th April

28th April to 2nd May

The course can be offered on a one to one basis with the instructor, or groups of up to three people can also take part. Statistics show that Motorcyclists are amongst the most vulnerable of road users and the course is designed to enhance riding skills, thereby reducing the risks associated with motorcycling.
