Also from the police Authority reports we find that in 2005 the NWPf owned 72 police stations, 33 Police houses, 7 radio masts and 692 vehicles. If the above timetable represents 26 stations what is the situation with the other 46 stations. We think we should know.

Our several members who served in the force only a few years ago tell us that “Almost without exception, all the police stations contained in the list would have been resourced and open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. There were very many more police stations in large villages such as Mochdre, Old Colwyn and Penrhyn Bay which were open from 9am – 1am the following morning although these were not continually manned. Now, with almost double the number of police officers in North Wales, there is not a single one, in any large town or village that is open 24 hours a day. That is a management decision and continues to be, very much, a political decision.
